

EMS Student Dress Code Hot Spots

- Clothes should always have a proper fit and always cover undergarments. Appropriate undergarments are required.
- Face must be clean-shaven; no beards, goatees, or mustaches.
- Tights and leggings may only be worn as an undergarment. (i.e. under dresses or skirts that are in dress code.)
- Excessively torn jeans are not allowed; no holes or “shredding” over 4 inches above the knee**
- No tank tops, spaghetti strap tops, racerback, or low-cut clothing (neck or underarm)
- Sleeveless shirts are not allowed for males and must follow the “three finger rule” for females.
- No “Sagging,” “Bagging,” or “Dragging” of pants.
- Hoods, bandannas, caps, or head covers should not be worn while inside any campus building.
- Slides, flip-flops, and house slippers are not permitted to be worn at any grade level. (i.e. footwear must have a backing)
- Shorts/Dresses/Skirts/Walking shorts/etc.; all must be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee**.
- Heavy spiked hair, mohawks, and unnatural colored hair is not allowed.
- Hair may not cover a student’s eyes at any time.
- Males’ hair may not touch the top of the shoulder.
- See-through outerwear must have clothing underneath that complies with the dress code.
- Visible body piercings are prohibited except for earrings for female students. No spacers, bars, or gauges will be allowed.

Campus administration will make the final decision on dress code

****--The high school and middle school will use the “fingertip rule” to determine 4 inches.**
